Not to mention, he gained national recognition on Golf Channel's *The Big Break: Mesquite*.

Options range from an unlimited-practice plan for just \$125/month for single members to family and couples' memberships up to \$200/month. From Two Worlds to One Table: Miah and Daniel

In the heart of Pinehurst, North Carolina, where small-town charm meets vibrant community life, a remarkable love story is unfolding. It's the story of Miah Magno and Daniel Gironda—a couple bound by a shared passion for food, music, and creating spaces that bring people together.

ROOTS IN FOOD AND FAMILY

For Daniel, the kitchen is more than just a workplace—it's a legacy. Growing up in the bustling kitchen of Vito's, his family's Italian restaurant that has served the community for 45 years, Daniel learned early that food is family.

Every member of Daniel's large Italian family has contributed to the restaurant's success. His grandmother, however, carved her own path in Hollywood, building a celebrated 25-year career as a hairdresser; styling some of the biggest stars and working on iconic films including *The Shawshank Redemption* and *Forrest Gump*. His grandfather earned a place in the Myrtle Beach Shag Hall of Fame, further weaving passion and tradition into the Gironda family story.

Daniel himself has always been driven by ambition. Before building a business with Miah, he managed several kitchens and was a notable figure in the disc golf world, winning multiple tournaments along the East Coast. As a teenager, Daniel was also the drummer for *The Oxygen Thieves*, a heavy metal band with regional acclaim, sponsored by Jägermeister and even fronted briefly by WWE's Jeff Hardy.

While Daniel's roots run deep in Pinehurst, Miah's journey began thousands of miles away in the Philippines. Moving to the U.S. at 13, she quickly found her place as the family chef—an early responsibility that sparked a lifelong love of food and fearless culinary curiosity.

Her father, Allan Critchett, is an inspiring figure in his own right: a former top tennis player who chose a life of missionary work over professional sports and Wall Street riches, dedicating himself to serving vulnerable communities around the world. Miah's mother, a competitive bodybuilder, fueled her daughter's love of music, encouraging Miah's



early gift for singing—so innate that she was said to sing before she could talk. Miah later competed in international singing contests across Europe, further honing her craft.

WHERE TWO STORIES BECOME ONE

Their paths crossed in a quaint café that featured live music—Daniel was on stage performing, while Miah worked behind the counter. Their initial meeting was brief but impactful, especially for Daniel, who soon reached out to Miah to collaborate musically. What began as a spark quickly blossomed into a deep connection.

Within a year, they had traveled together, moved in together, started a business, and become engaged—a whirlwind romance fueled by shared dreams and mutual passion. “When we knew, we just knew,” Miah says. “Neither of us wasted time building a life side by side.”

BUILDING A LIFE IN PINEHURST

Today, Daniel and Miah make their home on a quiet Pinehurst street just minutes from the Village—their favorite place in town. Here, surrounded by neighbors who have become

friends, they enjoy a lively household that includes their bulldog Mateo, two cats, and an unusual but beloved collection of eight snails living in a hobbit-themed aquarium.

Together, they perform music as a duo with plans to expand into a full band. Their travels always include stops at five-star restaurants, blending their love for food, culture, and adventure. Daniel keeps the competitive spirit alive through fantasy sports leagues, while Miah channels her creativity into marketing and design.


